## CONTEST RULES

1. All entries must be located in Simpson County, Ky.
2. All entries must be visible from a city, county or state roadway and cannot limit vehicle visibility in any way or cause an obstruction to traffic. All right of ways must be observed and not infringed upon.
3. Any type of hay bale, straw bale, loose hay, or straw is acceptable for entry. All entries must contain hay or straw bales of some types. Any other objects can be used in the entry. Creativity is encouraged.
4. Name your entry using the words Hay or Fall
5. No entry fee to enter the contest. Deadline to submit an entry is midnight, Oct. 16, 2023. A completed entry and a digital photo must be submitted via email to [tourism@franklinky.info](mailto:tourism@franklinky.info). Any entries received after midnight on Oct. 16, 2023 will not be accepted for entry in the contest.
6. This is a family friendly event. Simpson County Tourism reserves the right to exclude any inappropriate entries from the official trail map.
7. Displays cannot be professionally created by an outside company.
8. All entries will be placed on the Franklin-Simpson Tourism Facebook page for voting by the public for the "It's Fall Y'all Award." The display with the most votes will receive the "It's Fall Y'all Award" and a \$150 F-S Chamber of Commerce Gift Certificate.
9. A winner in the Business Category and a winner in the Residential Category will each receive a \$100 F-S Chamber of Commerce Gift Certificate. A panel of judges will choose the winner of the Business and Residential categories. ALL winners will be announced on Nov. 1, 2023.
10. The location of ALL entries will be placed on a Google Map for the Simpson County Hay Bale Trail.
